

## III CONCURSO CÁTEDRA HISPALYT / CERÁMICA PARA CONSTRUIR



#### 1.THE COMPETITION

Hispalyt "Ceramic to Construct" Chair, it is a university chair to foment activities and educational initiatives that serve to fortify the ceramic materials at project level.

The previous competition Hispalyt Chair, which was created in 2006, promoted a Brick Investigation Center with great results

The Chair is sponsored by Hispalyt (Spanish Association of Bricks and Cooked Clay Roofing Tiles Manufacturers) through an agreement with the Madrid Polytechnic University.

This course, the Hispalyt Chair, in collaboration with the London Metropolitan University the KTH Architecture and the Built Environment of Stockholm, la Facoltá di Architettura di Napoli and the Università IUAV de Venezia, summons a Public building in the historical city of

Toledo in order to define an explanatory space, a center of tourist information and a viewing-point of the city.

This contest of architecture represents the continuity of the international presence of the Chair, initiated in the previous edition and that is triyng to consolidate in the next years.

#### 2.PAVILION DESIGN CONDITIONS

There is architecture in Toledo of different periods and diverse styles. The urban plot of the historical city is dense for topographic, cultural and technological reasons and has few opened spaces. Only the squares that tied to the big buildings of Baroque Churches, have demanded of the city the adapted distance for his fronts.

In case of the Church of the Jesuitas, to the northwest of the Cathedral, it joins to the existence of this opened space, a topographic situation raised with regard to

the city that turns it into a point adapted for the location of a high view-point. The scale of the buildings, the narrowness of the streets, do not allow to have a vision of the city. Only the view is possible raising over the covers.

This competition proposes an attached lot to the square for the accomplishment of a center of information, with the location of a model of the city, spaces of reading and consultation of publications, and raise to a viewing-point of the needed height for the sight, that is evaluated in approximately 20 meters of height. Obviously they must not be considered the municipal binding ordinances. The offer of the competition spreads also to the square, a fine approximation must be looked to the reality of the ceramic materials, on the other hand consubstantial to the architecture from Toledo, using the brick as material protagonist of the building and the square

It is an aim of the Chair that the building, beside having an explanatory - functional function, could be a singular offer from the architectural point of view, and at the time that it constitutes Hispalyt's commitment for with the modern architecture that serves to transmit the common history of a material and a thousand-year-old tradition.

The location of the building has been fixed in the environment of the square near of the Jesuits church, between the streets of Alfonso X El Sabio and the street of the Trinidad. The lot for the building is approximately 85,00 m², and the square is approximately 1.200,00 m²

The project will include the following program:

A / Treatment of the set of the square

B / Building:

Room of exhibitions with a model of Toledo, receipt and information, small library of public access with 10 meters of rack, 5 Positions of consultation and reading for four persons every position, services, stores and personal wardrobe.

Access to viewing-point, with facility of use for handicapped persons. Viewing-point.

# 3.PARTICIPATION AND INSCRIPTION CONDITIONS


1 sealed non-transparent envelope in A4 format

Motto entry in the left inferior corner. In order to guarantee the anonymity all the proposals will appear under motto constituted by two letters and four digits
